

Client Consent to Working with an Intern

Some services provided by Beyond the Mirror are rendered by counselors-in-training who are receiving advanced training in the counseling program at their university. They are supervised by at least one senior staff person on a weekly basis. Clients have a right to know the identity and credentials of the supervisor(s) involved with their case. Supervision and taping are parts of this advanced training.

Counselors-in-training routinely record sessions by audios and/or video in order to review their work with supervisors. I grant permission to Beyond The Mirror and my Counselor Intern to make video and/or audio tape recordings with me for supervision. I will always be notified when tapes are being made, and may refuse video and/or audio taping of interviews at any time.

When meeting with a counselor-in-training, supervisors may observe sessions by attending the session either in person or via the telehealth meeting. I understand that my counselor-in-training may have one or more sessions observed by a licensed counselor and grant permission to Beyond The Mirror, the Counselor Intern, and the Licensed Professional Counselor to observe my sessions as part of the advanced training provided to counselors-in-training.

- I understand I am working with a Counselor-in-training and understand they are receiving weekly supervision, that they routinely record sessions, and that a supervisor may observe the session.
